  - i. Registration for 2023-23 School year is open! 200+ students on the waitlist, our school is growing! Pray for how to navigate the challenges of this
  - ii. Early Learning Program ON PAUSE for 2023-24 school year. The Society has been looking at how to deal with this because the school does not have the space anymore to accommodate this program because of expanding grades/classes. Portables were looked at but cost prohibitive, rental space in the area not feasible because spaces do not want the liability of dealing with small children.
  - iii. HCA Expansion gymnasium expansion we are close to finalising the details. Hopefully, next meeting we will have some info on this. Question: why would we do a gym while we have a waitlist? A K-12 school with one gym creates a logistical nightmare for scheduling and creating quality opportunities for students.
